Please download Weduc on your phones/lpads or other devices to keep up to date with all the communication and notices from the school office.



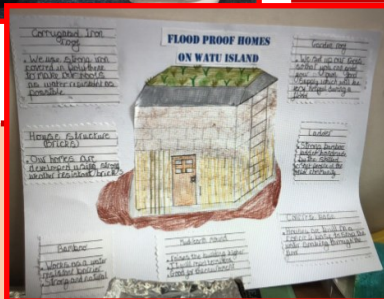
If you require assistance with this, contact Gill, in the school office and she will be more than happy to help.

We also have a school Twitter account @primary_newtown if you use Twitter, give us a follow, as regular school updates and reminders will get posted.



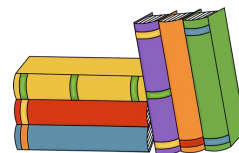
Soon we will have a brand new website which will be much easier to navigate and use.
