Year 1 - Adding by counting on

Year 2 - Make arrays

Can use Primary Stars slide to help

We are going to look at these groups in arrays. An arrangement of objects, pictures, or numbers in rows and columns is called an **array**.

Let's begin to look at rows.

Build an array with the apples

How many equal groups do I have? How many in each group?

First, how many apples in each row (split the apples to show them in rows). How many rows are there? Count them together. As you are talking, write this down for the children to see. How many apples are there altogether?

Have another go with some different objects, looking at rows again. Go through the same steps.

Main task

Using the premade table on the next slide, recreate the different images using objects from your house or the online resource. Work out the rows and write down the number sentence to match. Teacher to model filling this in.
