We've looked at life jackets and the history behind the Titanic, let's look at lifeboats and different kinds of boats there are!

A boat is a type of vehicle that floats on water. They can be used in lots of different ways!



This is a cruise ship. It is a large ship that carries people on voyages for holidays, typically calling in at several places.

You can spend up to a month on a cruise ship meaning it has lots to do.

Some cruise ships can carry over 6,000 people on board.

It uses large propellers to push the boat through the water which is powered by electricity.

This is like the Titanic as this also carried a lot of people and went on a long journey.



This is a ship. The large sails on the boat catches the wind, which allows the boat to move forward.

They were used a lot in the past to transport different items like food and material.

In movies, you usually see pirates on these kinds of ships!

Today, we don't need to use these for transporting objects. They are used for entertainment and are much smaller.



This is a canal boat. People live on these boats and travel down the canals.

They are very slow and can only fit around 8 people inside.

They are very long and people like to use these to have trips away in or to see new places around the country!



This is a kayak. This can usually fit either 1 or 2 people on the boat.

To make it move, you have to use paddles which push into the water to make you go forward.

These are used for exercise and entertainment. People like to do extreme sports in kayaks like sailing down river rapids!

These are just a few boats that people use. Here are some more boats that we haven't talked about.
