Assessments

As you may be aware there are some upcoming assessments in various year groups. We have summarised these below.

Year 1 Phonics Assessment

In June Mrs Hamm will assess the Year 1 children on their ability to read a combination of real and nonsense words using their phonics knowledge. You will find out how your child did after the assessment.

Year 2 Statutory Assessment Tests

During the month of May Year 2 children will complete various assessments in reading, mathematics, grammar and spelling. These will be completed under test conditions but in small groups. You will find out how your child did after the assessment.

Year 4 Multiplication Check

During the month of June Year 4 children will complete an online assessment to assess their multiplication knowledge. Please keep going with Times Table Rockstars!

Year 6 Statutory Assessment Tests

On Tuesday 9th May until Friday 12th May children will be completing their SATs. This will be in the mornings. These are then marked externally. Please can you ensure you child is well rested on these days so they can show their potential.
