The School Council are running a poster competition.


As next week is Road Safety Week the school councillors invite children to design a poster that can be placed close to school reminding drivers about speeding, parking safely and watching for pedestrians.

who was also a builder used to do this for us but is now no longer at the school.


Does anyone have the expertise or equipment to help? If so please speak with the school office. We are expecting delivery towards the end of November. Thank you!
