Key outcomes: This history-based theme will look at the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain. Children will learn about Julius Caesar, his attempted invasions and the successful invasion by Claudius. The theme will look at how the Romans changed Britain and the impact it has had upon Britain today including technology, culture and beliefs. Children will locate Rome in Europe and surrounding countries. The children will also learn about Boudicca and her rebellion.
