The children did lots of work and made displays about the First World War as part of this and the oldest children acted out the story of the Christmas Truce. In turn, this led to school working with members of the local community so that we could have our own war memorial which is located in the playground near the Linford class learning den. It was dedicated in 2015 and is the focus of our remembrance each year.

On 19th November, Bella, Erin and Sloane represented our school at the annual inter-school Talk the Talk event held at Brookvale Groby Learning Campus. Undaunted by the large crowd they spoke confidently and enthusiastically on their chosen topics: 'Our Planet', 'Animal Extinction' and 'Littering' respectively.
