Sometimes unexpected problems can create difficulties which need support to help resolve them. Our aim at Newtown Linford Primary School is to do what we can to support members of our school community. We can provide this support in the following ways:

Pastoral Support

We provide help in school to support a child to improve their social, emotional and behavioural skills.

- Turn-taking and sharing
- Boosting self-esteem and confidence
- Anxiety interventions
- Building peer relationships
- Zones of Regulation
- Transitioning to a new class, key stage, or school
- 1:1 Draw and Talk sessions
- Social Communication groups
- ELSA (Emotional Literacy Support Assistant) sessions
- Five trusted Adults
- Worry Monsters
- Referrals to the Mental Health Support Team
- Additional transition support

Parental Support

Help can be needed to address challenges at home, this can be due to family illness, financial difficulties or other misfortune.

- Signposting to local services or websites both on our bulletins, newsletters and on the school website.
- Mental Health Support and School Nurse information at parent events
- Help completing household support forms
- Access to the SENDCO
- Flexible payment plans for trips and activities
- Provision of school uniform
